

Arrangements for Extra-Snowy Weather Conditions



During the winter months, heavy snow usually creates problems for the transport and for safety of pupils at school.

These are the principles upon which we act and how we will respond:

- ✓ It is our intention to keep the school open at all times – wherever possible.
- ✓ The safety of our pupils and staff is always paramount.

In the event of heavy snow – overnight:

- ✓ Please keep an eye on our **website** www.byroncollege.gr, **Facebook page** www.facebook.com/ByronCollegeGR and your **personal e-mail** which is registered with the school as we will update you on what is happening via these main channels.
- ✓ If the local authority instructs us to close – we will do so, and parents should not bring their children to school. Please also keep an eye on our **local municipality website** as it will announce the mayors decision www.pallini.gr
- ✓ Parallel to the above announcements, the **school bus monitors** will contact the parents of the pupils on their buses by phone.

If it is snowing, but the local prefecture has not instructed us to close, we will attempt to work as normal. The school buses will collect as many children as they can do safely and monitors will be in constant phone communication.

Public Exams

In the case of heavy snowfall on the day of timetabled public examinations, pupils **will have to make their way to the school** in order to sit their exam which will take place as scheduled.
